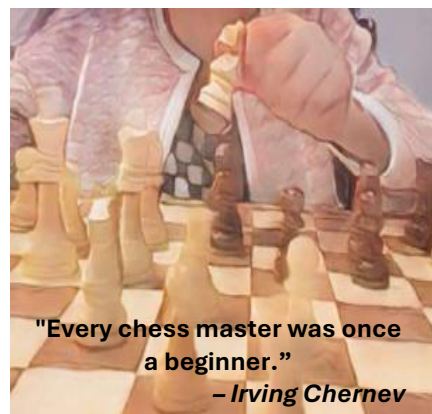

## Why Chesscolastics?

Chesscolastics is a chess learning centre designed to help you improve your chess skills. We offer courses for all levels, from beginners to advanced players, with lessons that build on each other. Our experienced and qualified instructors (FIDE-rated and chess masters) provide interactive lessons, practice tools, and live coaching. We provide everything you need to learn, practice, and get better at chess.



## REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Chesscolastics offers a series of courses in sequence to allow students to acquire basic concepts and moves in chess. Each level has 10 lessons, 1 tournament session, and 1 review and assessment in the series (12 sessions in one term).

- Online classes are grouped into various cohorts and levels – Beginner, Advanced Beginner, and Intermediate.
- Group classes per term cost \$329 (inclusive of taxes) for 12 sessions and are paid upfront. Students have the option to pay monthly or by term.
- Online classes for group and private lessons are held via MS Teams; each class lasts one hour.
- A maximum of 10-12 students will be accepted per class to provide a maximum of personalized support.
- A minimum of 4 students are needed to run each class. Our team has the discretion to cancel courses depending on registration.

- Individual private lessons are also available on a flexible schedule. Please contact us for rates and availability.
